November 14, 2024

The Xenia Township Joint Trustee and Zoning Boards held a meeting on November 14, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. at the Xenia Township Office, 8 Brush Row Road, Xenia, OH 45385; this meeting was advertised on the Xenia Township website within 24 hours of scheduling the meeting.

Steve Combs called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Mr. Foster started the meeting with an introduction of himself. He stated that there is a need for affordable housing in Greene County and that there is developable land in Greene County. He stated that the Land Use Plan will protect land being developed without losing all of the Agricultural land. He then stated that development should be close to Greene County water access, but that there will still be a need for alternative sanitation.

The next discussion was how Annexation is a threat for Xenia Township because Xenia City wants to expand and Xenia Township is stuck on what can be developed because of lack of water and sanitation access. It was then said that they want Xenia Township to grow with what the citizens want.

The next topic was Xenia Township Land Use Plan. The Character Zones were read and discussed. It was stated that there needs to be research on what type of housing growth is wanted in Xenia Township in keeping with the Township feel so as the homes were not on top of each other. It was then stated that they need to figure out what Xenia Township does and does not want in the Township and work toward that goal.
